

Perfect Fit Blinds

There are three types of **Perfect Fit** blinds

- Roller
- Venetian
- Pleated/Hive

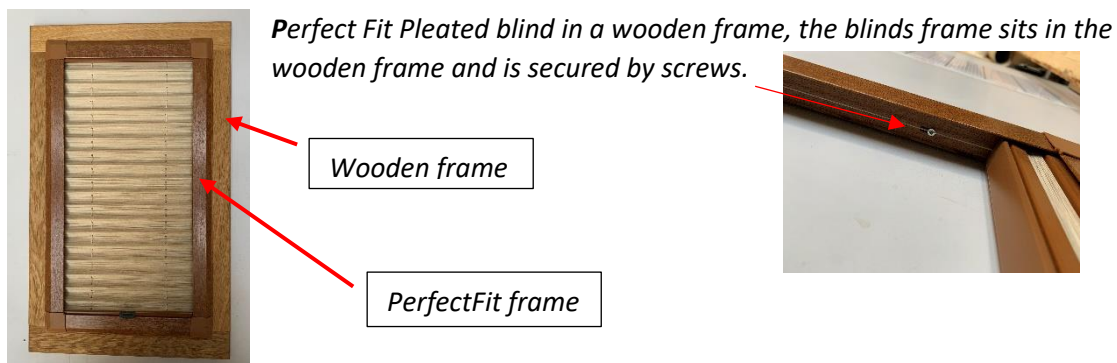
The common factor of these blinds is all three operate within a frame.

Perfect Fit blinds were originally designed to fix to PVC windows and doors, without the need for drilling and screwing, however they are a great choice to furnish the windows in boats.

The beauty of these blinds is that the blind is contained within the frame which provide the following advantages:

- When used on sloping sides of a boat they will not lean away from the window into the cabin.
- If the water is rough, the blind is contained and won't rattle against the cabin sides.
- They are 'Child safe' by design.
- No cords are used to operate the opening and closing of the blind.

However, these blinds require a frame to fasten into, up until very recently a frame would be needed, made from wood and fastened to the cabin side, to which the Perfect Fit blind is located and screwed to the frame to secure.



Because producing a bespoke wooden frame is a skillful task, we have a new product which is called **Perfect Fit Universal Frame**. The great thing about the **Universal frame** is that it can be built and installed by an amateur, and your Perfect Fit blind simply 'clicks' into place.
